

NACM CREDIT & FINANCIAL DEVELOPMENT DIVISION - SEATTLE CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP QUALIFICATIONS

Please make sure you meet all qualifications before applying. Scholarships are awarded during the CFDD meeting after the scholarship deadline. We put the names of the applicants for each scholarship in a box and draw one name for each scholarship being awarded.

Eligibility for all scholarships:

1. All Accounts with CFDD Seattle Chapter must be current.
2. Application must be made in writing and submitted to the Education Committee on or before the deadline date stated on each application.

Classification of Scholarships and Qualifications by Class:

1. **Class I: Local and regional scholarship:** i.e. college credit, financial and general business courses, seminars, state legislative, CBF, CCE exam, and NACM sponsored class fees.

❖ Qualifications

1. The applicant must have been an active member for six (6) months from the date of approved membership by the Board.
2. The applicant must attend a minimum of three (3) meetings within the six (6) month period prior to the month the scholarship is awarded.
3. Qualifications A & B will be waived for NACM sponsored classes only. In addition, the scholarship recipient must pass the course with a grade of C or better. If the passing grade of C or better is not received the recipient will reimburse CFDD for the full amount of the scholarship.

2. **Class II: National Scholarship:** i.e. NACM Credit Congress, NACM Legislative Conference.

❖ Qualifications

1. The applicant must have been an active member for one (1) year from the date of approved membership by the Board.
2. The applicant must attend a minimum of three (3) meetings within a six (6) month period prior to the month the scholarship is awarded.
3. Be currently serving, Chairing, or have served / Chaired one (1) CFDD Seattle Committee in the past two (2) years, OR have served on the NACM WWA or the National CFDD or National NACM Boards or Committees in the past two (2) years.
4. An applicant will not receive the same scholarship in two (2) consecutive years unless no one else has applied.

3. **Class III: Special Scholarship:** i.e. Mid Career, ACES, CMLI, Graduate School

❖ Qualifications

1. The applicant must have been an active member for at least two (2) years, and attended eight (8) or more meetings in the year prior to the month the scholarship is awarded.
2. The applicant must have served on at least one (1) committee during this period of time.

Eligible members may apply for the following scholarships during any given fiscal year:

- ❖ One (1) seminar
- ❖ One (1) local or regional conference
- ❖ Unlimited general or business-college courses. If the general / business scholarship is not used in three (3) months from the date of being awarded, it will then be awarded to the Alternate with another three (3) months stipulation to apply
- ❖ One (1) CBF Exam fee to be used in the current fiscal year
- ❖ One (1) CCE Exam fee to be used in the current fiscal year
- ❖ One (1) National Credit Congress
